GENERAL DESCRIPTION: Under regular supervision. . This position is responsible for maintaining acceptable ice conditions. This individual will be trained completely on the operation and maintenance of the Zamboni. Applicant will be expected to assist with ice installation and removal. Will need to be proactive in seeking potential ice surface problems and take the appropriate measures to rectify any issues.

This individual will also be responsible for opening and closing the Annex facility for various skating sessions/events throughout the week. Position is responsible for overseeing staffs working public skating sessions and therefore must possess excellent customer service skills. This individual will frequently work with families in preparation and operation of Birthday parties at the rink. Position is also involved in facility cleanliness prior to and after sessions.

This individual must be able to enforce ice skating rink rules and policies effectively. Applicant will work in skate rental working with patrons to get skates that fit. Individual will also be responsible for operating a skate sharpener for regular skate blade maintenance and other skate maintenance items such as replacing laces.

This is a seasonal position that primarily runs from October through April.

JOB REQUIREMENTS: Experience running and maintaining small equipment would be helpful for this position. Ice rink experience is also an advantage to anyone applying for this position. Customer Service is a critical element of this position as the individual will be working with a variety of people including children, parents and senior adults.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS: (Reasonable accommodations may be substituted for the physical requirements listed below). Be able to maneuver effectively within an office environment. Must be able to withstand working in cold temperatures (50 – 60 degrees). This individual should be expected to work long hours on their feet. Considerable walking on level surfaces as well as steps should be expected.
